Who is this event for?

Mix and Match is a community event for people living in the inner west end of Newcastle

What is its aim?

The aim of the event is to bring local residents together with key people from the council, the health services and other agencies to discuss issues of local concern. We want it to be a real opportunity to influence plans and services affecting the area

What will happen on the day?

There will be workshop discussions which will focus on issues that have been identified by local people through several months of consultation - issues such as bus services; litter, graffiti and other environmental issues; activities for children and young people; new social rented housing; and local health services.

The event will be launched by Doug Taylor, Chief Executive of the Newcastle Partnership, and Catherine Fitt, Head of Children's Services at Newcastle City Council.

The event will end with a tea party where storyteller Chris Bostock will give a performance about local experiences of community involvement in planning and decision-making

Lunch and other refreshments will be provided.

There will be opportunities for informal networking and for getting information about what's going on in the area
