

## Neighbourhood Services Priority Plan - Ouseburn

NS Ref.	What is the problem?	Where is it?	What are we going to do about it?
872	Waste Management & Recycling	Various locations throughout the ward	All households in the ward have now received blue <a href="#">recycling</a> wheeled bins unless they opted out of the scheme. We are also working to improve on and deliver new street recycling bins. This scheme is ongoing and will focus on metro and bus routes/stations
561	General cleanliness of back lanes which includes wheeled bins being left out following collections	Ward Wide	We are working in partnership with <a href="#">Northumbria Police</a> who accompany us on ward visits to promote good/safe wheeled bin practice, as wheeled bins have been known to be used to scale walls to access properties, hide tools to illegally enter properties and also to store stolen goods in. Action is also directed by the Safer Neighbourhoods and Action Problem Solving groups (SNAP's). The Neighbourhood Response Team will also continue to monitor the condition of the back lanes throughout the ward. We are also carrying out an initiative to educate new students moving into the area, through the use of wall planners which will be located in a common area in all multi-occupancy properties in the ward. The wall planners will advertise key messages such as refuse and recycling collection days etc.
706	Preservation of Green Space. Improvement action required	Shieldfield Green	The Neighbourhood Response Manager and <a href="#">Ward Coordinator</a> will work in close conjunction with the Parks and Countryside section and Your Homes Newcastle to maintain and develop an improvement plan for this area. Among the suggestions for improvements have been new seating and bulb planting.
682	Parking problems	Byron Street	Byron Street has been included in the Councils Local Transport Plan for 2009/10. A walkabout is to be arranged with Councillors and local residents in the near future to look at the issues in the area and identify possible solutions to the parking and transport problems.
703		Battlefield	Several schemes have now been implemented in the Battlefield area to improve parking problems: Lime Street - Parking restrictions have now been implemented with the aim of improving access and road Safety. We will also be carrying out some targeted enforcement in the area to prevent problematic and illegal parking.
854		Breamish Street	New parking facilities have been implemented and there are plans to install road humps and a 20MPH zone in the near future.
916	Residents consider vehicles to be travelling at excessive speeds	Heaton Grove	The traffic management plan for Heaton Grove has been delayed slightly due to the recent bad weather. Work was scheduled to begin on Monday 4th January 2010 and will commence as soon as possible.
