251	Tree replacement	Grange Estate (and possibly Ward Wide)	<p>Officers have worked with Councillors, residents and consultants to look at planning ahead for the replacement of street trees on the Estate. Recommendations include new tree pits, verge improvements and the narrowing of certain roads. A pilot scheme has been completed on Kingsway - after several consultation events a decision was reached to remove and replace all trees in the street. Street lighting and highway improvements were also carried out.</p> <p>Cranbrook Avenue is being considered for further works. Funding for highway and tree improvements is currently being sought.</p> <p>A rolling programme of tree inspections takes place every autumn where diseased trees are removed and replaced with healthy trees, where possible.</p> <p>To view the Council's Tree Strategy, click here.</p>
242	Condition of some roads	Ward Wide	<p>The majority of roads in Brunton Park and Melton Park have now been resurfaced, the most recent being Chapel Close, Brackenside, Glamis Avenue (including cul-de-sacs) and Belgreen Avenue.</p> <p>The remaining streets in need of resurfacing will be added to the 3-year Planned Highway Maintenance Programme and considered in order of priority. 252	Tree roots are lifting the footpaths	Halls Estate	<p>There is an ongoing programme of footpath renovation. Many footpaths on the estate have already been improved, with the remaining 2 streets (Linthorpe and Langholme) to be included in Engineering and Design Services' 3 year Planned Highway Maintenance Programme.</p>

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625	Poor layout of the road	Polwarth Drive	<p>Technical Services have drawn up a scheme to remodel the layout of Polwarth Drive in line with public consultation which is now agreed.</p> <p>Legal orders have now been advertised and, depending on the outcome, work is provisionally scheduled to take place in November 2008.</p>
857	2 hour restricted parking has been requested	Brunton Park Shops, Princes Road	This will be the subject of legal consultation. This consultation consists of related information being printed in the local press and displayed on signs and lamp posts in the area.
858	Outstanding adoption issues	Knightsbridge Court	The Council has been assisting residents with their concerns and has ascertained that the Developer has now appointed an Officer to deal specifically with the adoption issues surrounding Knightsbridge Court. The Neighbourhood Response Manager will also check the condition of roads.
965	Residents have difficulty crossing the road at busy times	Broadway West (near junction with Great North Road)	Potential scheme designs are currently being considered by Councillors and Officers, including a pedestrian refuge (island).
