

Newcastle City Council Development and Allocations Plan 20152030 Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulations 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is given that Newcastle City Council adopted the Development and Allocations Plan 2015-2030 on 24 June 2020.

A number of modifications were made to the Plan pursuant to section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. The Inspectors Report and its appendix set out the Inspectors recommendations for main modifications, and concludes that with the recommended main modifications, the DAP satisfies the requirements of Section 20(5) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) and meets the criteria for soundness in the National Planning Policy Framework.

In accordance with Regulations 26 and 35 of the 2012 Regulations the following documents have been made available:

Any person aggrieved by the Plan may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Act on the grounds that:

- The plan is not within the powers conferred by Part 2 of the Act;
- A procedural requirement of the Act or its associated Regulations has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made to the High Court not later than the 6 August 2020. (this represents a period of six weeks for applications beginning with the day after the date on which the Plan was adopted).
