Dear Resident,

Stamfordham Road/Springfield Road – Highway Improvements

I am writing to advise you of forthcoming highway works at the junction of Stamfordham Road / Springfield Road.

The changes are required to allow better management of traffic and take into account housing developments nearby. The improvements include some small changes to the junction to provide better facilities for people using it while improving the management of traffic through this area. The works are funded by national funding from the Housing Infrastructure Fund (HIF) and through contributions from housing developers.

The works represent "Phase 1" of improvements on the Stamfordham Road corridor; larger scale improvements may be delivered in the future when funding allows.

The changes are shown on the attached plan, and further information on the background to the scheme, public consultation and approvals can be found here:

Works will start at Stamfordham Road / Springfield Road later in October and will last for around 12 weeks.

We are working with Bus Operators and National Highways (who own and manage the A1) to minimise disruption during the construction period. We will also use our social media channels to communicate information about these works.
