17. Apologies for Absence

18. Minutes

The minutes of the meeting held on 29 June 2017 were confirmed as a correct record and signed by the Vice Chair

19. Vacancy – Parish Councillor

Members were advised that following notice given, the Parish Council was now able to co-opt to the vacancy. It was therefore

Resolved: That Rachel Locke be co-opted to the Parish Council for the remainder of the current term of office

20. Police Matters.

PC Pattison was present to update members on reported crimes in the area. He also advised that there had been 37 calls to the police in the last month.

Members raised concern about cars being driven in the village that were likely to be uninsured and drivers unlicensed, illegal tipping at the allotment site, red diesel being transferred to cars and youths climbing onto the Community Centre roof.

21. Planning Matters

Members expressed concern about vehicle accessing and exiting the development site at the east end of Coach Lane and the excessive mud on the road. Site staff parking under the fly-over was presenting a problem. Members also felt that site lorries should be prevented from travelling through the village.

22. Financial Matters

Members agreed to fund the purchase of anti-climb paint at a cost of £29 for use on the Community Centre to help deter climbing on the roof.
