41. Proposed future Primary and Secondary School Provision on the Simonside Site

(Note – Councillor Hunter, as a member of the City Council's Planning Committee, took no part in the discussion of this item or the voting thereon)

The Chairman welcomed Mr. M. Firth to the meeting.

Mr. Firth explain by way of a written report (copy in Minute book) that there were proposals for major housing developments to the west and north of the City which will result in an increase in the number of school places to accommodate them and it was estimated that a new 1000 intake Secondary school would be required. A number of sites had been considered but it was felt that the Simonside site was the most suitable. A related issue with the building of a new school on this site was the Community Centre. However it was possible that this could be relocated to the community building on the Gala field.

Having heard all the pros and cons the Parish Council

Resolved: To support the proposals in principle.

Councillor Hunter advised the Council that the application for a grant had been successful and it was hoped to have a meeting with the City Council officers in the very near future to progress the preparation of the plan.
