

**The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012
Notice of Submission of the Newcastle City Council, Submission Development
and Allocations Plan 2015-2030 (DAP)**

Notice is given in accordance with the above Regulations that Newcastle City Council have submitted the Submission Development and Allocations Plan 2015-2030 (DAP) to the Secretary of State for Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government on 13 March 2019 for independent examination.

The Submission DAP 2015-2030 together with the supporting documentation, submitted to the Secretary of State, are available to view and download on the Newcastle City Council website: www.newcastle.gov.uk/localplan2. Paper copies can be made available to view on request.

The submitted documents include:

The DAP will now be subject to an independent examination to be conducted by the Planning Inspectorate. This is a continuous process running from the date of submission through to the receipt of the appointed Planning Inspector's Report. Part of this process will involve hearing sessions where those invited to attend will have the opportunity to respond to matters raised by the appointed Planning Inspector. These hearing sessions are likely to take place in summer 2019. The Inspector will check that all legal requirements have been met and review and listen to comments from residents, stakeholders and businesses, as well as local evidence.
